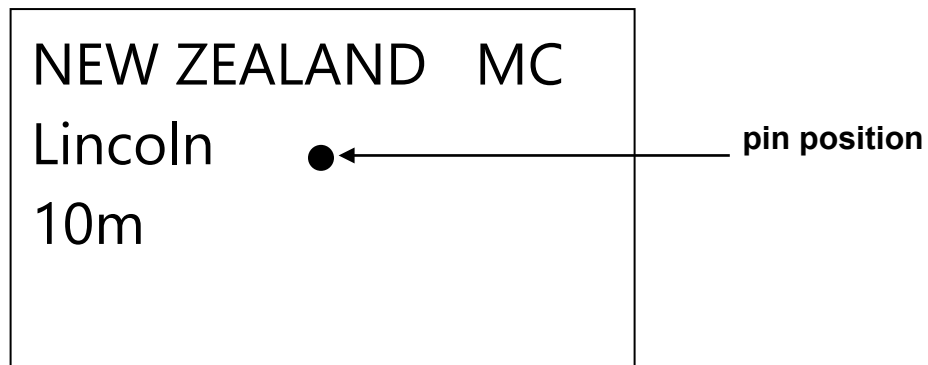
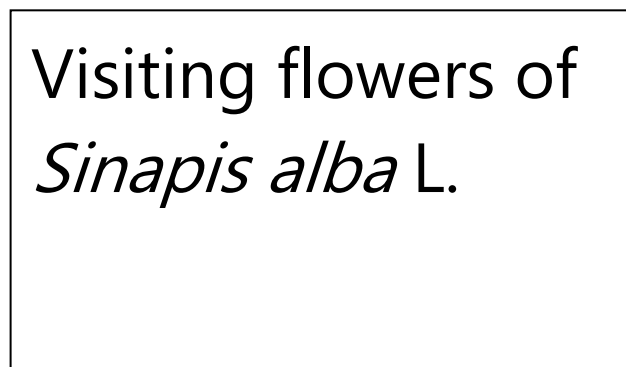


## Insect labels

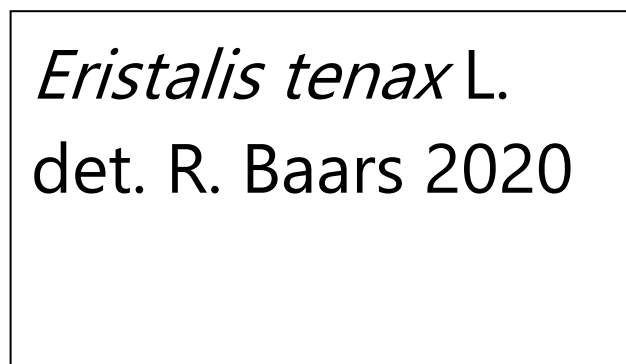
Label 1: locality, date and collector are recorded in that order.



Label 2: additional information - for example, the plant on which a flower visitor is found.



Label 3: the species name of the insect, along with who identified the insect, and the year.
