
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Islands with IAS (Invasive Alien Species) eradications: 569

Total number of IAS eradications on islands: 704














**Fig. 3.** Cumulative area of successful eradications by decade on 100 New Zealand offshore islands for which eradication dates are known.





#### Core eradication principles

- All target animals are put at risk by the eradication technique
- Removal exceeds their rate of increase at all densities
- Immigration must be zero in the short and long term









Figure 5: Motu Teuaua with 140 main surface bait points (red) and 13 additional cliff bait points (green).



3. Is it worth re-attempting islands with initial failures?




#### The Project Process Overview
